The Staffordshire Quilt – A Collaborative Textiles Project for Staffordshire Day’s 10th Anniversary

To celebrate the 10th anniversary of Staffordshire Day in 2026, We Are Staffordshire is launching a county-wide creative project that brings together the skills, talent and imagination of our college and university students.

The Staffordshire Quilt will be created from individually designed fabric squares, each one crafted by a student.

What the quilt represents:

Each square will tell a story - celebrating:

- Staffordshire’s creativity and artistic heritage
- The county’s landscapes, places and communities
- Local history, industry and innovation
- What Staffordshire means to the next generation

Together, these pieces will form a large collaborative artwork that showcases both Staffordshire’s identity and the exceptional work happening in its creative education sector.





Who can take part?

FE Colleges and Universities across Staffordshire are invited to register their interest. Participating students will typically come from:

- Textiles courses
- Art & Design
- Fashion
- Applied Arts
- Creative and vocational programmes with textile elements
